We recognize that a safe working environment can be sustained only through the effort of all crew members. Your attitude as a worker and cooperation in the promotion of accident prevention will assist in achieving our goal to make our boat a safer place to work. Remember to always stop and think, use common sense, and **DO NOT** take any chances with your safety. If you see an unsafe situation, address, and report it.
