- S** Set a visible example of your commitment to safety by sharing and promoting best practices and encourage an open safety culture. Always preform each task with the required safety measures, never ignore the safety rules to complete a task on time.
- A** All injuries are preventable by taking the time to identify any hazards. Find and record possible hazards that may be present in your work environment.
- F** Follow all regulations, policies and procedures put in place. A safe workplace starts with all crew members following the safety requirements.
- E** Ensure a safe workplace by making sure that all crew members have access to and complete all safety training. Comprehensive training is a must.
- T** Through the implementation of health and safety polices, your crew can prevent incidents and stop crew members from getting hurt. Always focus on prevention.
- Y** Your crew members safety is number one. Having regular meetings to review safety rules and discuss prevention to keep workplace safety fresh in crew members minds so that when something does happen, everyone knows what to do right away.
